“The Royal Family Honor Code”Part 2

1st John 2:9-11; John 14:15-27; 2nd Timothy 3:1-7

The devil is the highest of all angelic creatures, ruler of all fallen angels, the greatest creature genius who ever lived as a pre-historic super creature and he will have had 3 falls by the end of history; Isaiah 14; Ezekiel 28 and Revelation 12 and 20.

The devil is the major antagonist in the angelic dispute and he has an organization which has set some of the nastiest traps in history, Ephesians 6:10-12.

The devil is the original murderer; the opponent of biblical truth and he's the enemy of the church , the royal family of God.

There's a counterfeit Gospel in 2nd Cor 4; counterfeit ministers in 2nd Cor 11; counterfeit doctrine in 2nd Tim 4:1; a counterfeit communion table in 1st Cor 10:19-21; counterfeit spirituality in Gal 3:2-3, counterfeit righteousness in Matt 19; a counterfeit plan for living in Matt 23 and counterfeit power in 2nd Thess 2:8-10.

False teachers with their phony hypocritical facades using human public relations systems of legalism are a part of devil's strategy and trap as an appeal to human pride.

The Bible is the key to historical interpretation related to God, the unseen world of angels and the visible world of mankind as it's the only book that clearly defines the seen and unseen issues of history.

In 1st John, the apostle's main point is to restore believers to the intimacy of experiential abiding fellowship with the Lord Jesus Christ which produces confidence in Him and courage toward circumstances.

Being on the same team as the Lord Jesus Christ and God the Holy Spirit is the first step to greatness in life; the second step is consistently, actively, experientially abiding in intimate fellowship with Jesus Christ, the True Vine who nourishes all branches.

There's no excuse for a believer in Christ being on the wrong side of history.

Reprobates disqualify themselves and there's nothing worse than being smart and disqualifying your brilliance or having a talent and disqualifying your use of that talent.

Grace provided everything necessary for our success; saving grace, living grace, greater-grace, dying grace and surpassing grace.
