

1st John # 45 “Righteous Love” 1st John 2:29-3:1

To do what is right in God’s eyes requires one to be born again, so people who practice righteousness are those who know, understand, believe and apply the concept of God’s righteousness.

God’s character and integrity are produced in His children through the work of God the Holy Spirit in conforming them to the image of God’s Son.

The source of all blessing, discipline, testing and punishment is the integrity of God.

Righteousness is the principle of divine integrity and justice is the function of divine integrity and there’s nothing man can do to corrupt the integrity of God and man’s self-righteousness, sinfulness, good deeds or morality cannot influence the integrity of God.

God doesn’t need our help; we need His help.

While love is often an anthropomorphism to explain God’s policy, it’s not the source of blessing or testing from God.

God does love us because we have His righteousness but the justice of God is our point of reference with Him.

Justice demands justice and righteousness demands righteousness, so what righteousness demands, justice provides.

All blessing comes directly from the justice of God directly to the righteousness of God and not to us personally as God blesses us because of what He is, not what we are.

God is faithful and there’s never been a time when He has not been faithful.

Even when we are faithless, He must remain faithful and true to Himself for He cannot deny Himself or His righteousness living inside us.

God is infinite energy and power and infinity characterizes all that God does; His expressions of integrity, His honesty and His Word of truth.

God the Father who originally gave the Church Age plan of God to Jesus Christ at the Virgin birth, now gives it to all believers in the Church Age with no exceptions.

The understanding and application of impersonal love in the plan of God demands total concentration from the believer since it’s the backbone of the Christian life and the spiritual function which is the only way to glorify our Lord.

God has given us a special designation with a commission that gives our lives meaning and purpose, no matter how bad any situation may be at any given time in history.

If we don’t do it God’s way, we’ll never be happy.

As Church Age believers, we are children under obligation to our Heavenly parent; God the Father.

The thing that challenges the cosmic world system in this Age is the greatest challenge that's ever come to Satan as the ruler of this world and that is thought.

There was always something supernatural to encourage people but all of that is gone along with the temporary spiritual gifts related to miracles, tongues and healing, so the challenge to this Age and the challenge to Satan's cosmic system is thought living in the believer's soul, preserved in writing for the entire course of human history since the time of Moses.
