

1st John # 50 “God’s Stimulus Check for You” 1st John 3:5

1st John 3:5 views the imputation of all personal sins of all people to Jesus Christ on the cross with the result being their judgement by Father in His Son and from that judgement comes salvation.

Our personal sins were never and never will be imputed to us for judgement because they went to court once and for all.

In the plan of God, there are two judicial and five real imputations.

The two judicial imputations include first, all personal sins of all mankind to Jesus Christ on the cross and secondly, His perfect righteousness to all believers at the point of salvation.

The five real imputations include: the spark of human life to the soul, Adam’s original sin to the sin nature, eternal life to the human spirit, blessings in time to God’s perfect righteousness in us and blessings in eternity to the resurrection body.

Man’s condemnation is the result of a real imputation and man’s salvation is the result of a judicial imputation.

The mature believer has the best in life, something better in dying and better than the best in eternity!

God delivers the mature believer from death until it’s time for him to die and then He delivers him from the usual horrors of dying and God’s decision in these matters is based on His prior knowledge of all the facts.

We do not have the reality of eternal life until our soul is outside our body in the presence of the Lord.
