

1st John #52 “Have You Tested Positive for Jesus Christ’s Love in You?” 1st John 3:9-10

Christianity is not a religion; it’s a living, vibrant relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

The apostle John specifically refers to a believer who’s involved in experiential abiding fellowship with God’s seed or His Word abiding in him and in that condition, he can’t sin because he’s not able to when he’s being led by the Holy Spirit.

Being a disciple is different from being a believer because discipleship requires learning and so, a disciple is a serious student who not only hears his Master but obeys Him because he trusts his Master to know what’s best for him.

No believer is strong enough to manage on his own strength in this life, so he’s either under divine power inside the plan of God or he’s under satanic influence inside the cosmic world system.

Believers who are experientially abiding in fellowship with Jesus Christ have integrity and express impersonal love when facing the problems of life.

The believer who walks in the darkness of Satan’s cosmic world system cannot fulfil the basic virtue of the Christian life, the function of impersonal unconditional love.
