

2nd John # 5

“Walking in Obedient Love” 2nd John 6; Colossians 3:1-10

In literal walking, we’re generally moving forward and in spiritual walking, we’re advancing in the plan of God; so in literal walking, we’re using physical energy and in spiritual walking, we’re using divine energy from the omnipotence of God.

Spiritual energy or spiritual power to fulfill the plan of God comes from available divine omnipotence for God’s newly created spiritual species to freely use.

Physical walking remains one of the best exercises; working entire body to some extent, improving circulation, breathing capacity, supporting regularity and strengthening the heart.

By analogy, spiritual walking works our soul’s spiritual skills, building spiritual muscle, increasing the circulation of biblical truth in the soul, increasing application of the Word, eliminating the waste of Satanic and human viewpoint from the soul, replacing it with the spiritual nourishment of divine viewpoint, strengthening the soul by constructing a soul-fortress to protect and defend us from the outside pressure of adversity and prosperity.

To advance in the spiritual walk and be a winner, we must be living and functioning in experiential abiding fellowship with Jesus Christ producing momentum inside the plan of God and to retreat in the spiritual life and to be a loser, there must be living and functioning and retrogression in Satan’s cosmic world system.

Living in the experiential plan of God is the source of our spiritual energy as we use divine power to execute the purpose of God, creating momentum in the spiritual life.

At salvation, we’re transferred to light; positionally in Christ but our position is not always our experience and Scripture clearly indicates that believers still have sin natures and still perform works of darkness and even though they’re sons of the Light, they can live or walk in darkness.

All precedence for the plan of God comes from from our Lord’s walk on this earth during the First Advent and this means that no precedence comes from from the Age of Israel.

Walking as children of light means we will become spiritually mature believers or invisible heroes.

We have the option to not obey this command in Romans 13:12 and continue to live in darkness guaranteeing a life of misery from divine discipline coupled with an embarrassing loss of eternal rewards.

So, even though the Church Age believer is light from positional truth, it doesn’t mean he’s living as light, experientially.

Light and darkness are absolute opposites; we’re either light or darkness and we either walk in light or we walk in darkness.

During that entire time of judgment, our Lord remained in the prototype plan of God and so He was sustained by the omnipotence of the Holy Spirit and His maximum usage of God's perfect happiness.

The First Advent is an experiment in the sense of a demonstration; first was the demonstration of the power of God the Holy Spirit and second was the demonstration that any believer who advances to spiritual maturity, acquiring God's happiness, can endure anything in life because of the omnipotence of the Holy Spirit and happiness, our Lord was able to endure the cross.
