“Christ in You, the Hope of Glory” Col 1:25-29; 2nd Cor 3:6-8;

The Mosaic Law proves that we are sinners and need Jesus Christ but the Law cannot give us life, power or stability; nor can it enable us to live the Christian life successfully.

Sabbath keeping, along with all forms of shadow worship and all activities of the specialized priesthood are out, no longer in operation.

Sadly, in our day, through ignorance of New Testament Church Age doctrine, we find many sincere believers still living under the Law, having ignored the new dispensation of the Church.

But there is a glory that does not fade; a glory that gets brighter and brighter; the glory of the indwelling Holy Spirit mentoring one’s life.

Do you realize that as a believer in Jesus Christ, you have a higher glory than the Law? You have a glory that will not fade away, that does not require a veil over your face?

And it’s produced by the Holy Spirit influencing your life and not only does He produce the character of Christ in you, He produces the ability to understand the Word of God and that’s power, my friends!

Our understanding of the Word, our prayer life, our worship and our witnessing for Jesus Christ depend upon the Holy Spirit’s influence in our lives.

We cannot serve for Christ apart from the ministry of the Holy Spirit in and through us, period!

Capacity for life, love, blessings and happiness means that soul distractions have been removed by growing up spiritually which often includes suffering.

When we have capacity for life, we keep our priorities straight.

When we have capacity for life, we are occupied with the Source of our bless, the Lord Jesus Christ.

My friends, are you looking for love, confidence, courage, peace, contentment and stability?

What you’re looking for, you already have and it’s not your own doing, it’s He who lives

inside you; He's the Holy Spirit, your Advocate, Teacher, Mentor; He's everything we could possibly ever need to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ!
