

Habakkuk #4

“God Knows Best”

Habakkuk 1:1-11

Divine discipline is punitive action taken by the justice of God in grace to correct, encourage, train and motivate the believer’s free-will to the plan of God.

When we as believers get out of fellowship through sin, human good or evil, we bring suffering on ourselves and if we don’t use God’s most basic problem-solver; recovery, we’ll continue in a state of carnality, worldly living or rebellion.

Only in time are we, members of the royal family of God, disciplined in suffering.

All divine discipline, except the sin unto death is always designed to correct, train and motivate.

Jesus goes to the cross and stays on it because He has biblical truth in His soul and He’s built a soul structure with a foundation of God’s Word and the filling of the Holy Spirit, so He fulfills the Father’s plan for His life.

Jesus has biblical truth; He uses it and He goes to the cross and Jesus’ disciples will get encouragement from this because they’ll know that their Lord remained focused until the end and all sins were judged *Jesus is saying; even though you’ve failed, grace is going to take up the slack for you because I’m going to win the battle for you in that “I have overcome the world” and that is grace; the work of God; what Jesus Christ did at the cross and that’s the ans to your life right now.*

A resurrection body is what God provided for us and this is the hope of glory and our glorious future is why we can have confidence now.

This groaning is the idea of hurting badly and making some kind of noise about it.

The human body is the tent and inside it lives the real person, the soul and we keep on groaning because in addition to the pressures that come from pain in the body, like loss of health or injury, there are intense pressures upon the believer’s soul.

At the point of salvation, the Church Age believer was given the indwelling Holy Spirit as a down payment on power for this life, for joy and blessing for the soul in the presence of the Father.

So while we do not have bodies when we go to be with the Lord, we are still indwelt by the Holy Spirit.

Confidence is total assurance of mentality, having a mind with fixed divine viewpoint standards that are unshakeable whether we’re in disaster or prosperity, regardless of situation, we are mentally unshakeable.

In everything, we can have total absolute confidence when we’re relying on the inner resources of biblical truth and the filling of the Holy Spirit provided by God.
