

James 32 “Useless Faith” James 2:17-20

Faith is not something we do; it’s a channel or a conduit in which we appropriate what God has done for us!

We have a powerful object for our faith; biblical truth and we believe the Word of God as it’s taught and listening and applying it adds profound strength to our faith.

Complete focus on the Person of Jesus Christ is the final level of success we can reach to face every difficulty of life and demonstrate the greatest possible power available to man; the omnipotence of Almighty God!

The objective in salvation is for God’s love and His eternal life to come to man but it can’t be done at the compromise of His righteousness or His justice.

The only way that God’s provision can function in our lives is for us to make His Word the Working object of our faith every day and there’s no place, then, for any human glory to get in the way.

All believers functioning under operational death have faith but their faith does not have a working object because they are in arrogant rebellion, counting on their human good which is nothing more than filthy rags in God’s sight.

Faith after salvation is still in the soul of all believers but now experiential sanctifying faith has to produce to be seen as effective in reaching the unbeliever.

An outward demonstration of faith with a working object is the production of divine good but faith without a working object is useless, non-productive and obviously observably dead.

When you do something great that reflects your faith, that is experiential vindication or justification by works but doing something great doesn’t get anyone into Heaven, only faith in Christ does that.

Human history is here to prove that Satan’s appeal is ridiculous.

The demons are scared and unbelievers should be too; fear is a thinking sin leading to the production of mental attitude sins which attack the soul and anything that attacks the soul is attacking our vital lifeline.
