

“Proud And Presumptuous” *James 4:11-17*

The foolish believer is negative toward biblical truth and negative toward post-salvation sin recovery, so he quite simply never grows up spiritually.

Judging means to have some information on someone, erroneous or not and use it against them anyway and whether it's true or false, both are equally sinful.

All our sins were imputed to the perfect human nature of the Lord Jesus on the Cross and He freely accepted this imputation and its sentence because He had undeniable, unwavering, unconditional impersonal love for all mankind.

Temptation in itself is not the sin but the volitional act of giving in to that temptation is definitely sin.

Biblical truth is God's perfect law of freedom and mental sins which sponsor verbal sins are an attack upon the spiritually mature life or God's perfect law of freedom; so, when we judge other people, we're attacking God's spiritual growth principle.

In the three categories of sin: mental, verbal and active physical sins; the first two categories are the worst, with one exception: murder which usurps the right of the Creator only to remove His creation as He sees fit.

Deliverance is the first hope for a rebellious believer here in our context and if he's still alive while in his emotional revolt, he can recover through confession and the application of pertinent Bible study.

Every believer who completes his soul structure has mastery of the details of life until he loses it through emotional revolt of the soul when his mastery over the details of life is replaced by his new found slavery to the same details of life.

An unstable unruly believer never really finds a permanent home to rest in because proper choice of location is based upon the intake of biblical truth, so instead for the rebellious, it's where can I next make a bundle of cash?

A spiritually mature believer doesn't ever depend on his pocket money or his sustained acquired wealth for his security or his happiness because he realizes that he possesses them on the permanent grace foundation of biblical truth; therefore, he can enjoy them fully!

But money as a god is materialistic lust and slavery to the details of life; so, the principle from the Word of God is that money is a useful, helpful servant or tool but a cruel, tyrannical master. Ignorance of biblical truth is the worst thing that can happen to any believer and the defiant do not really understand what kind of life they are going to have tomorrow.

In considering our lives, we have the directive will of God where we should be as much of the time as possible.

When everything depends on God, we can't miss His blessings.

The life of the emotionally arrogant is a vapor trail, seen for a moment and then it disappears but the life of a spiritually mature believer is a permanent monument established forever to the glory of God.

The greater your knowledge, the better your chances of making the right decision; the more biblical truth you have in your soul, the clearer the issues are that challenge your free will.
