And God is also happy with His plan of grace which is not only the ultimate expression of His perfect happiness but it's the source of our perfect happiness. The ultimate in happiness for us in time begins when we are filled with the Holy Spirit and it continues through the consistent intake of biblical truth and when our soul structures are completed, our happiness reaches its optimum. Those who persevere through testing in trials while being tempted to do anything but hang in there, are actually the happiest people around and God likes that so much that He's created a crown or reward for such behavior. We must always remember that we are responding to God's love and that as believers in Jesus Christ, we did not nor could we have initiated the love relationship we have with Him as that would be arrogant on our part to even consider. The only true comfort we can have when a loved one dies is the Word of God and if it's our source of peace when we lose a loved one, it is for every other pressure, problem, heartache or difficulty in life. 2nd Corinthians 5:1 speaks of what God has provided for all of us and this is our hope of glory related to our glorious future and that's why we can have great confidence now! The purpose of the Judgment Seat of Christ is to provide us with our efficiency evaluation which measures our love response to the Lord Jesus while we were on earth and this will occur after the Rapture when we become His bride and find ourselves in resurrection bodies. The winner is good only because he's fulfilled the experiential plan of God and that's why he'll not be ashamed at the Judgment Seat of Christ as will the loser. The 'Order of the Morning Star' is a decoration for those who led disciplined lives inside the experiential plan of God and it's the highest commemoration that God can give to a human being. Revelation 19:7 depicts the wedding ceremony and its reception and in verse 8, the 'fine linen' includes all Church Age believers in a reference to their imputed righteousness from God while 'bright' refers to winners of the Order of the Morning Star and 'clean' refers to these winners exchanging their uniforms of honor for their uniforms of glory! These winners bear a coat of arms which allows them access to the New Jerusalem as only the winner or overcomer can enter.
