James 2:21-26; Genesis 22:1-17; Hebrews 11:17-19

Abraham was vindicated through salvation justification at the moment he believed in Jesus Christ as he knew and understood Him and after his salvation, there came a time, many years later, when Abraham did something in which a maximum amount of biblical truth in his soul was used. Worship begins with hearing the Word and it's completed by doing or apply the Word as James tells us; the intake of Bible doctrine is the basic concept of worship and the output of Bible doctrine believed is justification by works. Momentum tests are related to God's special revelation given to us and Abraham's tests were designed to teach him about Who God is and that He is faithful to fulfil all His promises. The only way to pass tests in life like Abraham did is to have God's wisdom in our souls as he did and then as we apply it as he did, our faith works with our application to advance our spiritual growth as it did for Abraham and if we have Bible knowledge without application, we'll never advance spiritually and we'll remain miserable our entire lives.
