

John 17:20-26

The relationship between the Father and the Son is both perfect and permanent.

The Lord Jesus is absent from the earth today and we are His visible representatives here involved in the spiritual warfare of the angelic dispute and our power and weaponry is outlined clearly in the Word and plan of God for the Church Age.

The glories which the Father gave the Son as seen in our Lord's Phase 2 glory when He built a formidable soul structure and His Phase 3 glory when He received His resurrection body prior to His ascension are also graciously available to all of us!

As we are filled with the Holy Spirit and continue in Bible study followed by application, we build a soul structure that glorifies the Father because we're using building materials that He has graciously provided.

Because we are indwelt by the Holy Spirit, we can be filled by Him and then if we remain positive toward the Word of God, we can successfully build a soul structure which glorifies God. This is the Age of invisible heroes like you, that is of course, if you so desire to be one.

Jesus Christ gave us a glory that is incomparable!

Just as the Holy Spirit sustained our Lord in His earthly ministry, the same Holy Spirit sustains us.

There's never been a greater love than that of the Father for the Son and He loves you the same way.

How much does God love me? The Father's love for the Son is the only measure we have to compare His love for us too.

Our co-workers, friends, nuclear and extended family to include even our spouses don't always let us know that we are worthy of their love but God does!

Do you know that God truly loves you? If so, how can you possibly keep that to yourself? Spiritually, emotionally, relationally LOST people are all around us.

The Lord Jesus revealed the Father to the world and we who know both of them personally, can share in the precious intimacy that the Father and His Son enjoy forever! The Trinity provides our outline for a marriage where there are two equal partners and yet one by way of function has authority or position over the other, hence responsibility, yet this does not make one subservient to the other.

Our soul structures reflect the glory of our Lord and at the same time, they convict the world.

The prayer He prayed and the promise He made by the price He paid means that we're going to Heaven, guaranteed!

There is no part of the Word of God that cannot be mastered by any positive believer.

The building materials for your soul structure existed in eternity past by way of the Father's love.

The love of God cannot be counterfeited by Satan.

Jude 21 Keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life.

To know God and the nature of His essence, greatly improves our prayer life.

The key to overcoming darkness is to walk in the Light.

In John 17, the Lord Jesus reflects on His life and His ministry just hours before His death.

Our Lord's prayer in John 17 is basically an account of His life's work as to how He used His opportunities to glorify His Father.

So, we've got to ask ourselves: Are we continuing to spread His mission of hope?

And: Are we constantly sharing His love?
