

John 193 "Jesus Welcomes Heathens" *John 12:20-25*

True worship is a child of the magnificent marriage of grace and faith; it's a reflection from a positive mental attitude within the soul, not a demonstration of an outward posture of the body such as a prone or kneeling position, nor is it a specific verbal recitation of carefully thought-out pious sayings.

"GRACE AND FAITH"

Worship is not emotion or a feeling, it's thinking and therefore, the Christian way of life is based on having a proper mental attitude.

These 'hungry' Greeks approached a prepared person or did they?

Usually the less we know about most people, the more we can respect them; familiarity breeds contempt but with the Lord Jesus Christ, familiarity breeds content!

"See" is *horao* Gr which means to take a good look.

Philip's problem is: He can't think for himself.

DEITY NEVER SLEEPS!

Although Philip did not listen to biblical truth, he did listen to orders (Matthew 10:5).

Philip is ignorant of the mind of Christ.

And because Philip cannot lean on the Word of God, he must lean on Andrew.

If people do not regularly attend Bible class today, they would not have followed the Lord Jesus then.

The next best thing to knowing something is knowing where to find the answer.

The Lord Jesus Christ says in effect: "The Father has a plan for Me which will roll right along and it includes an opportunity for these 'hungry' Greeks to seek and find Me."

Interestingly, Jesus begins His speech to the Greeks by NOT discussing the resurrection even though that's what they came to hear about.

Jesus Christ had to come in the flesh before He could die in the flesh.

The Lord Jesus died voluntarily from the ultimate source of Himself and no one else.
