

John 196 “I Will Draw All People To Myself” *John 12:27-32*

**We won't be happy with what God has provided for us until we learn of His truth from His plan, so that we can become aligned with His timing and until then we're out of sync with Him.**

And if we neglect biblical truth repeatedly, we're out of God's timing until the day we die. *People are often confused, bitter, upset and even angry because of the way and the time someone they love dies, so they actually put themselves out of God's timing, sometimes for the rest of their lives, all because they arrogantly, mistakenly feel that somehow everything in life is unfair to them.*

**Bad timing is arrogance in life often manifested by jealousy and self-pity and therefore, our wrong timing in life will destroy our experience and make us miserable in life.**

To the extent that we feel sorry for ourselves, we're always out of sync with the plan of God, Who by the way doesn't feel sorry for us, He fixes us; so if it's related to arrogance and becomes the motivation in our lives, it's always bad timing.

*Timing in the Christian life remains the issue of choosing the will of God over our own will as it's always been the problem of arrogance versus humility.*

**The world's opinion of the Apostolic message of Jesus Christ hasn't changed.**

The goodness of God the Father was His Son's to freely give but the Pharisees refused it all! *Sinless, perfect Messiah, the innocent God-man never gives up as He makes one last far-reaching appeal to Israel in John 12.*

Perfect God cannot love imperfect man personally unless His Righteousness and His Justice

are completely satisfied first; prior to that, He could only love lost man impersonally *John 3:16.*

**The Lord Jesus Christ did not come into the world for the sole purpose of healing people or even telling us to turn the other cheek; He came to die for our sins in order to reconcile us to God.**

God the Father is glorified with the work of His Son on the Cross.

*Only through the work of Christ on the Cross on our behalf can the Father love us and still be consistent with His Holiness!*
