

John 21:3 “The Architect, The Builder And Our Dream Home” *John 14:1-3; Psalm 33  
Jeremiah 32:26-27; Then the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah: “I am the Lord, the God  
of all mankind. Is anything too hard for Me?” John 5:22, 30; 22 Moreover, the Father judges  
no one but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, 30 By Myself I can do nothing; I judge only  
as I hear and My judgment is just, for I seek to please Myself but Him who sent Me.  
Psalm 76:10 Surely Your wrath against mankind brings You praise and the survivors of Your  
wrath are restrained.*

If we are in love with the Lord Jesus Christ, we have confidence in His grace and not in  
ourselves; so when the bottom falls out of our lives, our hearts do not become troubled to  
the point of emotional sin because we believe in the omnipotent God, our Father and also in  
His Son.

Note that believers in Jesus Christ demonstrate their faith in 3 ways in Psalm 33:

1. They wait in hope, vs 20;
2. They rejoice in Him, vs 21 and
3. They trust in His unfailing love, vs 5, 18.

Rev 21:4 He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or  
crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

What’s the difference between us and the unbeliever facing death? We are not alone  
because we believe in the Father and His Son!

*The Lord Jesus is saying: “I’ll lift your vision beyond this world to a place where I’m going  
for the purpose of preparing room for you to come and join Me and you have reservations on  
Me.”*

1st Peter 1:3-4 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In His great mercy  
He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the  
dead and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in  
Heaven for you...

When we see the Lord Jesus, every fear we have or have experienced will vanish, every  
longing will be met and every false attempt to find happiness on earth will be exposed and  
immediately fulfilled in our Savior’s facial expression toward us!

Isaiah 65:17 See, I will create new heavens and a new earth. The former things will not be  
remembered, nor will they come to mind.

*I don’t want to hear from someone who’s had a near-death experience; I’d rather hear from  
someone who’s had a real death experience!*

Heaven is where the blind will vividly see, the deaf will clearly hear, the lame will briskly  
walk and the weak will be made incredibly strong!

Romans 8:18 I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory  
that will be revealed in us.
