

John 217 “No Eviction Notices Ever” John 14:1-9

Because the Church Age is the era of constant briefing and no longer ritual object lessons, success today means our rate of learning biblical truth must always exceed our rate of forgetting it.

In John 17:17, Jesus says to His Father: Sanctify them by Your truth, Your Word is truth. Experiential fellowship with God is so much more than just trying to avoid sin.

The three commands in John 14:1 represent the ultimate in virtue love.

At salvation, every believer in Jesus Christ passes the point of propitiation in which he finds himself under maximum divine personal love versus the impersonal love relationship all mankind has with God prior to salvation.

We cannot have a love for God or even a true perspective of the spiritual life unless we become aware of the potential we have for true love for God in our own souls.

The fact that we fail God doesn't nullify the irrevocable covenant He made with us the moment we first believed in His Son.

The many rooms in Heaven that Jesus spoke of are prepared for and reserved for believers based NOT on who or what they are or what they've done or not done, but SOLELY ON Who and what God the Father and His Son are and what they've done!

God's plan is greater than our sin nature, our failure, our human good, our sincerity, all our human viewpoint and self-serving motivation.

Even though one of our Lord's key disciples will fail in denying Him three times, Jesus will go right on with the plan!

Get it yet? The plan of God goes on in spite of man's failure.

Our Lord's preparation of our Heavenly home does not depend on our success or failure, it depends solely on His character and His work.

The advance of the Father's plan to the Cross does not depend on Peter or Peter's free-will choices, it depends on the free-will of Jesus Christ.

No free-will in the human race means no salvation for the human race.

The sovereignty of God and the free-will of man co-exist.

The Lord Jesus receives us to His side for the presentation of our resurrection bodies at the Rapture.

Peter and all the disciples have a glorious future with the Lord awaiting them!

Ignorance of biblical truth disorients us from the experiential plan of God.

Each of Jesus' questioners is saved as they indicated by calling Him Lord.

Since Thomas didn't understand, he assumed that no one else understood.

It is impossible to apply that which we do not know.

So, why not give yourself a fighting chance by daily processing the Word of God?

The Lord Jesus wishes to announce the Church Age and before there is a glorified bride, there must be a glorified Groom!
