

**John 220 “Slow Down And Take A Deep Breath” Part 2 John 14:10-15**

**Believers in Jesus Christ have choices every time any adversity, prosperity or any other situation which might be considered detrimental occurs.**

**If we constantly emphasize our relationships with people as a priority over our relationship with God, we’ll always have a very serious problem.**

**The problem of spiritual death was solved when our sins were judged on the Cross, so that the barrier between God and man could be removed.**

**Jesus Christ came to earth with the purpose of being the only solution to the problem of sin, there is no other solution except God’s solution.**

**Fear only sees the problem; faith sees the solution and we can’t solve problems with another problem.**
