

John 235 “Revealing Ourselves As Committed Disciples” John 15:7-9

A normal believer-priest is commanded by God to ask, seek and knock and if he’s filled with the Spirit and consistently in the Word causing him to know explicitly what the will of God is, it will come to pass.

Just as it took Gospel truth for our first inhale as new believers, we must have continued biblical truth intake if we are going to breathe spiritually.

The Father is perfect and His plan is perfect and therefore, His plan excludes human good. Whenever we find God being glorified in the Scriptures, it’s always based on His grace expressing His love without exception.

In the Church Age, there are no second class believers.

Our priesthood is just as important as any other believer’s to include that of John, Peter and Paul!

As long as we are in Phase Two of God’s plan, He intends for us to produce the fruit of divine good.

The words ‘disciple’ and ‘soul’ used here are feminine nouns.

In a true love relationship, a woman responds to her man from her soul before her body.

Promiscuity destroys all possibility of responding to the right man, her husband.

Just as a wife is designed by God to respond exclusively to her husband, a disciple of Jesus Christ is designed by God to respond exclusively to the mind of Christ or His Word first and foremost.

No one is born a committed disciple; we become committed disciples through daily intake of biblical truth under the filling ministry of God the Holy Spirit.

‘Agape’ love is a direct result of the filling of the Holy Spirit in our lives and ‘phileo’ love is a direct result of biblical truth constantly circulating in our stream of consciousness.

When the humanity of Christ inhaled biblical truth, He always followed with exhales of love and grace toward His own.
