“There’s Only One Person Who Cannot Blaspheme” And that’s the Person the Pharisees chose

to charge with blasphemy. *John 5:23-26*

The Lord Jesus Christ is among His own countrymen, His under-shepherds, the examples before the people and they don’t see or hear Him because of their religion.

People cannot just simply ‘not see’ the Lord Jesus Christ or ‘not hear’ Him without becoming hostile at some point.

John 5:24 denotes principle, not mechanics.

Acts 4:12 “Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other Name under Heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.”
