Lazarus is resuscitated in spite of the blasphemy from the Pharisees, the human viewpoint logic from the wise in their own minds and no positive faith response on the part of many present at the tomb.

The term ‘Blind faith’ was invented by unbelieving skeptics who contrived it in defense of their arrogant disdain for any accountability in life other than to themselves but actually they’re wrong because faith is never blind, it’s always people looking at and looking to the object of one’s faith.

Faith therefore is a non-meritorious (or non-crediting to the one expressing the faith) system

of learning in contrast to rationalism (reason) and empiricism (mechanical skill through use of the senses) which are meritorious or credit bearing to those expressing them.

And since the Lord Jesus did all the work for our salvation on the cross, the only way we can respond when the work is already finished is to believe in Him and then believe His words because that is

the only non-meritorious (or non-crediting to the one expressing the faith) system of learning anything and therefore, that is the only way all the credit goes to God where it belongs.

So, the filling of the Holy Spirit along with the consistent learning of biblical truth combine to give us the formula for successful spiritual exercise necessary for our experiential sanctification.

The choices we make determine the life that we live.
