

John 218 “Relax In Me Philip And Breathe Freely” John 14:5-12; Isaiah 55:7-9

What we think is what we really are; so we are NOT what we appear to be, we are what we think we are in our souls.

Philippians 2:5 In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus.

If we think like the Lord Jesus Christ and are filled with the Holy Spirit like He was, humbly authority-oriented with boundless unconditional impersonal love for all like He had, then we can relax like He did, perhaps like we never have, ever before!

Stability is the result of a relaxed mental attitude; Phil 4:7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Love is the result of a relaxed mental attitude in the soul; 1st Cor13:5 It (love) does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. If Peter, Thomas, Philip, Jude or any of the others including us are ever going to relax in this life, it will be due to our application of: Phil 2:5

In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus.

The desires of the heart in Psalm 37:4 are based upon our reaching spiritual maturity when we will not only have capacity for everything we face in life, not only all the blessings God has provided that are necessary in the spiritual realm but we'll also have desires that are compatible with our Greater-grace spiritual status; Jas 4:6

2nd Corinthians 3:14 But their minds were made dull, for to this day the same veil remains when the old covenant is read. It has not been removed because only in Christ is it taken away.
