

John 277 “I Gave Them The Words You Gave Me” *John 17:6-7*

A spiritually mature believer who is filled with the Spirit and consistent application of biblical truth, can confidently expect great things from God.

This is not audacity on the part of Jesus, it's cognizance of the Father's will.

Jesus Christ commands glorification.

Jesus must die for the sins of the world before His glorification is possible because His voluntary humiliation must precede His ultimate glorification.

Our Lord knows the will and plan of the Father and therefore, He expects the will of the Father to be done!

The more biblical truth we know, believe and apply, the more effective our prayer life will be.
Romans 10:17 Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message and the message is heard through the Word about Christ.

Jesus' completed work as the basis for His glorification gives His disciples the proper motivation to continue His mission in His absence.

Our purpose is to glorify God and the term is a brief lifespan and the ultimate result is sharing eternity with Him!

So, we learn God's thoughts, renew our thinking so that we love God's truth and live it.

The Lord Jesus Christ is the greatest teacher who ever lived; the God-man made the invisible, visible!

The Father made full provision (He 'gave' in vs 6) for all Church Age believers because the Church Age marks the intensification phase of the spiritual warfare we face, making us all targets of the enemy forces.

And some believers receive more attention from Satan than others.
