“Don’t You Know Yet That I Have To Do All This Alone?” Part 1

John 18:11; Ephesians 3:14-17

After talking to His disciples about the Father, Jesus talked to the Father about the disciples.

Worship is giving something very special that we all possess to God and that’s ourselves.

The choices we make, (not our upbringing, environment, social status or natural heritage) determine the life we live.

The disobedient one would undeservedly go free and the obedient One would die undeservedly to set all men free!

God Who is always in control, masterfully uses man’s injustice to satisfy His justice!

The greatest display of divine power is not in the taking of human lives but in the saving of human souls!

The wrath of Peter will not preempt the wrath of God the Father from being placed on His Son, Jesus.

We’ve established that the sword in Peter’s hand represents maximum human ability with minimum spiritual dynamics behind it. So just how do we get maximum spiritual dynamics in our lives?

Humility is an objective recognition of the greatness of someone other than ourselves leading to a true orientation to their honor.

Many people think you have to get on your knees to pray but that’s not accurate; truly successful prayer requires humble authority-oriented concentration and physical posture is not important.

This is the only dispensation in which there is royalty within the Family of God; so, we are the Patria of Pater.

Prayer is a result of an already established relationship; so, the daily function of learning, believing and applying the mind of Christ makes prayer, witnessing and all our other production effective.

And we must come to know Pater before we try to communicate with Him.

Since His grace is the basis of prayer, no believer can come to Pater in prayer and expect to be heard based on his human merit, ability or ingenuity.

The provision of God’s riches is based on His perfect character making it perfect and for anyone to know this, it must be properly communicated.

There never was a single problem, heartache, frustration, tragedy, success or failure for which God did not make perfect provision in eternity past!

The principle here is that God has these things to give and He does so as a part of our capacity developed from our experiential tactical victory in the angelic dispute.

The point is that God wants to bless us with material things in time but these things would be meaningless without the capacity to enjoy them which brings in the spiritual factor of spiritual maturity.

There is nothing in the essence of God that speaks of poverty or running around in rags, begging, whining and complaining all the time.

God is: Sovereign; Righteous; Just; Love; Eternal Life; All-knowing; All-powerful; Everywhere Present; Unchanging and Ever Truthful.

The human soul has a spiritual need at salvation which is similar to the physical need of a newborn infant from birth; 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 2:2-3.

It's God's purpose that Jesus Christ be at home in the heart of every believer but this is only true when a believer has constructed a fortified soul structure from his substantial soul inventory of God's truth.

The devil cannot duplicate the soul structure building plans of God the Father.

The intensification of the spiritual warfare in the angelic dispute demands an intensification of the intake and processing of biblical truth.

Satan has leveled his attack on the Word of God with zero success.
