

“Now Appearing Live And In Person” John 20:17-19

God's Living-grace-support includes a day at a time to execute His plan for our lives and only those days when we are in fellowship with Him have significance in the execution of His will for our lives.

The day-by-day life of the believer only has meaning when related to biblical truth application.

The dynamics of daily living must be related to biblical indoctrination.

Positive emotion appreciates and responds favorably to the truth while negative emotion disorients and separates one from the truth.

Mary stopped physically hugging the Lord Jesus at His command but she remains soulishly hugging Him for her entire life as she continues to express her personal love for God the Father as the primary motivating factor in her life!
