Unity in the body of Christ is achieved through individual spiritual growth with the same purpose in mind;
glorifying Jesus Christ.

Fulfilling our responsibility as Christians does not weigh us down, instead it liberates us.

Our level of faith will never go beyond our knowledge of God.

Our responsibility as Christians is not to fear or worry about tomorrow or to be overwhelmed with the cares of this world. It's to trust Jesus Christ and that's what is required of us who have so much.

1. There is encouragement in union with Jesus Christ.

2. There is comfort from virtue love because you have entered the door of hope on God's agenda into His unique spiritual life. 1 Cor 13:13.

3. There is fellowship with the Holy Spirit Jn 14:26.

4. Being merciful and compassionate is a part of joy or happiness.

5. Bringing joy to completion is thinking on the other side of the door of hope—the integrity of personal love for God the Father and impersonal love for all mankind.

6. Our one objective is maximum glorification of God.

Joy is accurate thinking resulting in proper emotional response to that thinking.

The emotion is not the joy but the response to it.

Joy is sharing the happiness of God and the invigorating response and excitement related to the pleasure of possessing both an eternal and temporal relationship with Him and so, sharing the happiness of God is joy brought to completion.

Joy and peace must be related to thinking because our fellowship is with invisible God.

The purpose of true Christian fellowship with God (the communication of biblical truth) is the completion of our joy.

Our Lord's joy was the maximum processed truth circulating in His stream of consciousness as a problem-solving technique when He endured the bearing of our sins on the Cross.

“United with Christ” portrays the principle of the baptism of the Holy Spirit where the believer is placed in union with Jesus Christ as the means of the formation of Royal family of God.

God is obligated by His grace to provide, sustain and plan for His Royal family.

When emotion responds to truth which the believer has in his soul, it supports him. God loves us and He shows it and we love Him because He first loved us and so, we love others in following His example.

Reason:

If we stay too long in the perimeter of the spiritual life, we will start to go backward.

The point is that no one can advance in the Christian life simply by *doing*.

Can you imagine the greatness of a family or a church that consisted of such people who put the needs of the team above their own?

This is not lack of confidence, it's lack of pride.

Hypersensitive believers are subjective about themselves and insensitive of others.

The subjective believer is totally aware of himself and his problems while being totally indifferent to the feelings and the problems of others.

The greater-grace believer must not only respect the privacy of others but at the same time, he must be very thoughtful of those advancing with him toward the objective.
