Romans 3:29-31

“It doesn’t matter what you believe, as long as you’re sincere.”

We should not only know what we believe but why we believe what we believe.

Every believer in Jesus Christ must take the responsibility for his own decisions.

In God's eyes, a true Jew has faith in Jesus the Messiah and the Spirit of the Living God inside him.

1. Sola Scriptura (“Scripture alone”)

The Bible alone is our highest authority.

2. Sola Fide (“faith alone”) We are saved through faith alone in Jesus Christ.

3. Sola Gratia (“grace alone”) We are saved by the grace of God alone.

4. Solus Christus (“Christ alone”) Jesus Christ alone is our Lord, Savior, and King.

5. Soli Deo Gloria (“to the glory of God alone”) We live for the glory of God alone.

It sounds good except for the vitally important missing word: ALONE.

The Spirit of God through the apostle Paul teaches that there’s no place in the Christian life for any boasting except in the work of Jesus Christ ALONE!

The 1st power option is the filling of Holy Spirit, in which God/Holy Spirit influences the soul with the divine power that causes the plan to work and the 2nd power option is the learning and application of His truth.

Timing is the selection of the best time or speed for doing something in order to achieve the desired effect with maximum results.

Our tendency is to depend on promises rather than on the integrity of a person.

We are benefitted more by the integrity of a person than by promises we seek to get from that person.

Mature believers or invisible heroes do not need promises from God because they depend on God's integrity and love rather than His promises.

When you learn about the integrity of God, you know that He cares for you under all circumstances.

The believer with discernment wisdom does not depend upon promises from another person, he depends on their love and their integrity, which he has been able to discern.
