“Safe and Secure” Part 2

Romans 8:38-39

We are not and never will be justified by our own righteousness or anything we've done; we're justified by the imputation of the righteousness of Christ which we received as a result of trusting in Him and so, God the Father's justice sees His righteousness in us and declares us justified in His sight.

God's personal love is now free to bless us beyond our imaginations without compromise because we have the same righteousness that He has.

Because we have His righteousness, there's no possibility of condemnation and we are secure in God's love.

God cannot condemn His righteousness!

There is no way a mature believer can die nor is there any situation related to death that will shake his poise or in any way destroy his confidence or complete sense of security.

The mature believer goes through whatever process of dying God has for him with total confidence of his security.

Neither the events of life nor dying are a cause of fear or distracting concern to the mature believer.

Present things we face in history cannot in any way destroy the mature believer's confidence in relationship to the plan of God.

God's plan and provision are greater than all the hostile powers of mankind.

Since God the Father loves God the Son with an eternal love, He also loves those who are in union with God the Son with that same eternal love.

Jesus Christ sent an advocate to minister to us in His absence and just as the Holy Spirit sustained the humanity of Christ through His earthly ministry, so the indwelling Spirit sustains us in life; John 14:12.

Privacy is a state of being apart from the observation and company of others; a principle of freedom and a God-given right of the human race to seclusion.

Privacy, property and life are the basic concepts of human freedom.

In addition to freedom and establishment, every believer

has privacy from his royal priesthood to fulfil the principle of living his life as unto the Lord.

When we stick our noses into someone else's business,

we are violating the very principle by which we live — freedom.

1st Peter 4:15 If you suffer, it should not be as a murderer or thief or any other kind of criminal, or even as a meddler.

Jesus Christ represents us as our defense attorney, advocating for us to God the Father when Satan attempts to condemn us for our sin, so our advocate-intercessor Jesus calls for exhibit A; that we have His perfect righteousness in us, so our sin is no longer an issue.

No one can condemn us because the judge is the Lord Jesus Christ, our intercessor-advocate; so no one can bring a legitimate charge against us because He paid for our sins!

Hebrews 7:27 Therefore He/Jesus is able to save completely those who come to God through Him because He always lives to intercede for them.

Romans 8:26 In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to

*pray for but
the Spirit Himself intercedes for us through wordless groans.*

**So, if we receive undeserved suffering as part of God's provision for us, no matter what happens;
even if our life is lost in the process, God is glorified!**

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?

*No one nor anything in the present or future emphasizing that it's the impersonal love from God
for us that saved us and His personal love that keeps us and this is not focusing on us; it's focusing on
the fact that we are in Christ; so because we have*

Jesus Christ's righteousness, we cannot be separated from the love of God, ever!
