“Our Problems and God’s Solutions” Part 2

*Romans 12:19-21 Ephesians 2:11-18*

**Quite frankly, we cannot love God unless we know God and we cannot know God unless we have processed enough related doctrine on the subject of God.**

So, personal love for God is the most difficult love of all to apply and maintain because it takes consistency in inhale and exhale of biblical truth.

*Peace with God is accomplished only because the sin problem is dealt with but we will never have peace with some people because the underlying sin is never faced.*

**Revenge or retaliation is a major violation of the RFHC because it causes a positive mature believer to abandon his own standards by violating the privacy of another believer’s priesthood.**

To lower ourselves to someone else’s standards by taking on revenge is blasphemy in failing to trust the justice of God to handle it.

*Retaliation which comes from arrogance in saying we can do a better job of righting wrongs than God can, brings compound discipline from God for interfering with the process of divine justice.*

Harmony demands that we respect the privacy of other people as privacy is the key to freedom.

To do our part in obedience to God’s command, it’s necessary to recover and be filled with the Holy Spirit, take in the Word consistently, live under the RFHC and truly love the brethren with a relaxed mental attitude toward all believers.

**All royal family disputes demand action from the justice of God rather than the revenge tactics of imperfect human beings.**

Two wrongs don’t make a right and retaliation is the prerogative of sovereign justice, so to add wrong to wrong brings down divine wrath on our own heads rather than divine discipline on the one who wronged us.

*This has nothing to do with socialism; it has to do with someone who despises us and it means the RFHC has a system which is far greater than any morality system, including the 10 commandments.*

The RFHC expects more from us than any other system and only a believer with maximum biblical truth in his soul can feed his enemy.

By feeding a hungry enemy, the positive mature believer leaves all hostility in the hands of the Lord.

**Our attitude of grace in feeding our enemy doesn’t depend on who or what our enemy is, it depends on who and what we are.**
