“Love Your Neighbor as Yourself.”

Romans 13:8-9 Mark 10:17-22

There’s nothing wrong with borrowing as long as we consider it an obligation that we will pay.

Believers have no right to renege on agreed-upon obligations.

The Royal Family Honor Code includes integrity and so, where obligation exists, we fulfil it.

This is not love expressed toward God nor is it spousal love or love toward friends; those are not obligations, they’re functions of freedom.

This command to love means to have respect for God’s righteousness wherever it’s found and also to have respect for the privacy of the royal priesthood.

This love is best expressed by promoting privacy in the royal priesthood which is absolutely necessary for every believer to live his life as unto the Lord without distraction or interference from others.

Murder is the unlawful killing of another human being with malicious intent expressed or implied.

A person defending himself or others from a criminal’s intent to inflict great bodily harm to him or them, may kill that criminal but that’s not murder, it’s justifiable defense of life.

Christian integrity is beyond establishment morality but it also includes establishment morality.

Morality is not the Christian way of life in itself but morality is included in the Christian way of life as part of the RFHC’s expression of Christian integrity.

Not only should we avoid murder but also character assassination.

Human freedom includes the right to own inanimate property under the laws of divine establishment.

Actually, Jesus is saying; if you understand what good is, you know that only God is good, so if you call Me good, you must know you're calling Me God.

This is a valid interpretation and in comparing Scripture with Scripture, it’s in line with all the rest of the Bible concerning Jesus and His claims about Himself.

In questioning this young man, Jesus is investigating to find out if he’s truly humble and teachable.

Spiritual maturity is priority #1 after salvation as part of our 2nd hope, so we never want to turn against the means by which we advance, which is freedom.

After spiritual maturity is achieved through maximum biblical truth in the soul and blessings in time, our 2nd hope is replaced by the 3rd hope of receiving reward at the Bema seat.

Hope always concentrates on God and His Word rather than seeking gain by violence or crime.
