“In Conclusion”

*Romans 15:33*

**God is all knowledge or omniscience revealed in the Bible: In Hebrews 4:12, it's the Word of God the Father; in 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 2:16, it's the Mind of Christ and in Hebrews 3:7, it's the Voice of the Holy Spirit.**

And why do we have the Word revealed? For guidance in Psalm 119:105, stability in Isaiah 33:6 and confidence in Psalm 31:15 and 1<sup>st</sup> John 2:3.

*And how does it become real to us? 2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 2:15 'Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.'*

The Spirit-filled believer produces a mental attitude and lifestyle which is an open letter from God to the human race, a letter written by the Holy Spirit; 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 3:3.

**Every believer uses his free-will to become a vessel of honor or a vessel of dishonor.**

Every wrong preconceived notion we've learned from childhood that contradicts the plan of God finds its way into our stream of consciousness.

*The Word of God destroys our preconceived notions, so now we must make a decision as to what is right: our preconceived notions of how great we are or the truth of the Word.*

Virtue, integrity and honor based on processed biblical truth bring happiness and that's our reality.

**Paul explains that the Gospel has to do with justification as God's righteousness is revealed in His condemnation of the entire human race because of sin and His only cure is faith alone in Christ alone.**

Experiential sanctification or spiritual growth is how God's righteousness is lived out or produced by God in the lives of those who've been declared righteous and justified; so experiential sanctification righteousness follows positional sanctification righteousness.

*Evangelism is part of our priesthood function to offer ourselves as living sacrifices, focused on and dedicated to the mission that Jesus gave us known as the Great Commission where we are to make disciples of all nations.*

**The good news is that Jesus Christ paid our debt in full, freeing all mankind from sin's penalty.**

We're born spiritually dead, lacking perfect righteousness under the condemnation of Adam's original sin.

*Jesus Christ paid the penalty for our condemnation but that still leaves us spiritually dead lacking righteousness.*

So, at the point of faith alone in Christ alone, we are positionally, legally forgiven of all sin and we receive a new human spirit at regeneration along with the imputation of Jesus

**Christ's righteousness, so we are declared righteous and are given eternal life being justified in His sight.**
