“Crushed Satan”

Romans 16:19-20; 2nd Thessalonians 2:9-10

The royal family God is every Church Age believer; regardless of background, race, gender or socio-economic status because all distinctions are erased at salvation.

Whatever we were before doesn't matter because we are now royal family of God, a permanent royalty that will last forever.
