“When were you Established?”

Romans 16:21-27; Acts 13:1-3; Acts 17:1-9

The only way we're going to have stability in life is when we base our life on God's Word, the only thing that doesn't change.

But if things continue the way they're going, the only way to survive is if we base our happiness on the Word of God and not people including self or things including pleasant circumstances.

Each of us has a spiritual gift for a reason related to the plan of God and we are to be faithful to the Lord by using our spiritual gift and doing our job as unto the Lord.
