“Obligated, Eager and Unashamed”

Romans 1:14-16

God set up the divine institutions for the entire human race (not for believers only) for its preservation, so that the angelic dispute is free to run its course and the human race is free to accept Jesus Christ or reject Him.

The Tower of Babel was a satanic device to try to frustrate the plan of God by breaking down, infiltrating and opposing it.

Internationalism results in a maximum destruction of human life on the earth, a minimum use of free will or freedom, maximum negative attitude toward God and a minimum amount of evangelism.

Internationalism actually abolishes national government, private property, inheritance, patriotism, marriage and family life and Bible Christianity and it makes the state responsible for education and sustenance needs.

The nation is a human barrier against the supremacy of evil in the world controlled by Satan (Prince of the power of the air) and it also protects from the power lust of the sin nature.

The purpose of nationalism is to provide protection so that individual free-will can operate under maximum freedom and liberty.

Most of the great nations have had a spiritual heritage that contributed to their adoption of establishment principles.

The apostle Paul is not only the greatest Jew of all, but he is also the greatest Roman as he represents establishment law and spiritual heritage definitively.

No amalgamation of people can be great unless they have something that unifies them and that is divine establishment principles.

The character of God, the free-will of man, the history of man's rejection of God and how these relate to the righteousness of God is explained in 'Romans'.

Because of the doctrine Paul teaches, the Roman believers will adopt his mental attitude and the fantastic golden age of Rome is yet to come.

Remember that our sense of honor is directed toward God and our sense of duty is directed toward people.

Hellenes originally meant Greeks, but eventually after Alexander the Great conquered the world it became related to the culture which was spread through the Greek conquests.

Paul's first obligation is for salvation adjustment to the Justice of God, followed by recovery adjustment, which leads to maturity adjustment.

“Wise” is a technical word for the born again believer who has advanced from the point of salvation through the maturity barrier.

The gift of pastor-teacher is obligated to both the positive and the negative believers in the royal family of God.

If we put the Word first and crack the maturity barrier, we will develop a sense of honor and integrity, causing us to fulfill obligations properly toward our fellow man.

Jesus Christ is where blessing begins and where everything in life becomes meaningful and has purpose.

Good news is anything that is encouraging to us and we all need all the good news we can get our hands on!

The greater the spiritual growth, the more effective is personal witnessing and the more effective is the spiritual gift of evangelism.

The believer is also an agent in witnessing, so it’s the responsibility of every royal family member.

Correct and accurate information is always the effective power.

However, if the evangelist does not clearly present the issue of the Gospel, then receiving the attention of the crowd is meaningless.

Personal social communication precedes spiritual communication, as illustrated by Jesus with Nicodemus, the Samaritan woman, Zacchaeus, the wedding at Cana, the rich young ruler, Simon the tax collector and Mary of Bethany.

The purpose of this phrase is to show us that whenever a man is well motivated in life, has capacity for life to meet any situation in life, there has to be a great explanation.

Technically this is good news of victory and good fortune, something of intrinsic value and it always refers to the whole realm of the Word of God.
