“A Foolish Exchange”

Romans 1:21-24

God’s wrath is all inclusive and justifiable; so man’s sin is inexcusable.

There will be judgment in life for the rebellious unbeliever and judgment forever if he does not stop suppressing the truth.

God is now free to bless the believer because his sins were judged on the cross and divine justice is not compromised.

The ministry of the HS in making the Gospel clear and His convincing man of sin under common grace, places the emphasis on mankind’s awareness of God’s existence.

The unbeliever cannot understand the Bible and so, the HS acts as the human spirit and makes the Gospel a reality.

No appreciation and no obligation means no capacity for life.

When the unbeliever rejects the Gospel, he loses any possibility of true happiness.

This futile or evil thinking comes from the negative reaction of the unbeliever toward the understood Gospel; or on the part of the believer toward Bible truth.

The actively rebellious unbeliever has a vacuum which draws anxious thinking and evil deliberation into the mentality of his soul.

Biblical truth is recalled from the frame of reference into the memory center for utilization.

The emotion is the woman of the soul and the heart is the man of the soul and that is why the emotion is empty unless it receives something from the heart.

The emotions as responders are designed to enjoy capacity for life but the heart as the dominant area is the initiator of that capacity.

When an unbeliever has understood the Gospel in his soul and says no, blindness results after his soul is filled with evil.

Paul is addressing intellectual people and he’s not complimentary or empathetic toward those who claim there is no God.

Every time any one of us recognizes and then suppresses the truth of God, our souls are affected traumatically.

Those who reject God over time, develop mental illness.

When someone continues to make decisions that go against what they know to be true, his soul and conscience break down.

When there is negative reaction at G/C and at G/H, a delusion occurs which has a powerful impact on history.

Delusion of maladjustment to the justice of God at salvation is the result of unbeliever active rebellion.

This explains the blindness of the sincere liberal, who has a guilt complex trying to use political power to solve man's problems.

To be the kind of fool described in Romans 1:22, there must be arrogance in active rebellion.

Self-righteous evil becomes creative and manufactures idols by which people can make contact with demons.

Those who reject God are spiraling downward when they believe they are progressing in their quest to deny the obvious.

They made their own god and that's incredible arrogance.

Arrogance of rebellion always seeks to corrupt the Incorruptible and the creative work of evil is to destroy the Incorruptible in the minds of others.

No one can destroy the incorruptible God, but they can surely create the wrong impression of Him.

Man is corruptible because of his sin nature; man is mortal because of death as a result of sin and man is perishable because of his human body.

Arrogance and ingratitude always go hand in hand.

***'Romans'* is saying it's not intellectual, social or educational, it's spiritual.**

***Paradidomi* means to deliver and in this case it means to deliver over to justice, the justice of the supreme court of Heaven.**

God is fair and just and if divine justice cannot bless, it must curse.

All judgment is committed to the Lord Jesus Christ.

The justice of God produces the action of the judgment of unbeliever rebellion.

In the lusts of the heart, when there is no category of truth to counter-balance, eventually evil comes from the mind over to the heart.

When God starts to judge the active rebellion of the unbeliever, He judges them first, by permitting them to enter into a system of dishonor.
