“A Worthless Mind is a Terrible Thing to have”

Romans 1:28-29

1st Peter 5:7-9

2nd Peter 2:20-22

No matter what anyone says or does, or how emotional they are, if they do not respect the object of their love, they don't have love.

The creature and his policy dominate the world today.

Satan has developed an acquired taste for believers who are positive in learning Biblical truth.

When you become Christ-centered instead of people-centered, you won't have a problem with people at all.

Do not check your common sense at the door when it comes to relating to people, including the body of Christ.

But if you choose to keep your eyes on people, you're in store for the biggest case of self-pity, you ever dreamed possible.

Being occupied with people and keeping your eyes on self leads to wanting to do something for yourself, which leads to eyes on things and then you've arrived at and are caught in the super-creatures trap.

Safety nets for everyone and no freedom to fail means no freedom to succeed.

This mindset magnifies to the maximum: insecurity, instability and fear of death, making for a population of full-time worshippers and servers of the super-creature, Satan.

Handing over to judgment occurs in both time and eternity: in time, the 5th cycle of discipline; in eternity, the lake of fire.

The judgment is the worthless mind or the mind filled with the satanic evil.

The worthless mind filled with evil keeps on doing evil things.

The unbeliever who has rejected Jesus Christ as Savior, after having understood Gospel information, has a worthless mind.

It is better for an unbeliever not to have understood the Gospel, than to turn away from it.

The believer who rejects Biblical truth develops a worthless mind.

- 2. Heb 5:11-14, he is unteachable**
- 3. Gal 5:4, he is a casualty**
- 4. Phil 3:18, he is the enemy of the cross**
- 5. Rev 2:4, he has left his first love**
- 6. 1 Tim 1:19, he is shipwrecked**

7. Jer 9:25-26, he is uncircumcised of heart

8. Heb 12:15, he is falling from grace

Remember the influence that comes when a person says no to divine truth of the Gospel.

“Being influenced by all anti-justice” is another way of describing evil infiltrating the soul.

Poneria in Koine Greek means the intentional practice of evil that comes from blackout of the soul.

Man’s freedom must be limited only by the laws of divine establishment but man’s freedom must never be limited by laws that try to solve his problems.

Sin in your life originates in the sin nature; evil originates from your heart.

Sin is handled by recovery; evil can only be handled by growth to spiritual maturity.

One of the greatest blessings of the greater-grace life is divine protection from evil in the angelic and human realms.

This category finds the justice of God abandoning the rebellious unbeliever to his own devices, taking off any restraints when the person wants more and more and more.

The intense desire comes between the thought and the action.

When a person is jealous of someone else, he is unstable.

Jealousy is a mental attitude sin which demands exclusive devotion and is intolerant of rivalry.

Jealousy is the basis for the destruction of spousal love.

Any true love can be in danger when jealousy attacks. *SOS 8:6.*

All positions of authority in the local church should be viewed as gifts and not as opportunities to use power as their own.

A trouble-maker is always cunning, deceitful and treacherous.

You cannot be occupied with the sins and failure of others and at the same time advance in the plan of God.

To interfere with the function of Jesus Christ as the Supreme Court judge in Heaven is to invite more disaster upon ourselves.
