“God is the perfect fair Judge” Romans 2:5-8; John 5:22-27

There’s a time coming, when things will be very different; a day when God will judge men. God will know of all mitigating factors and circumstances and He will not be deceived and so, His verdict will be just with no opportunity for appeal.

Men are aware through their conscience and what they see that God judges evil.

The moral self-righteous people whose morality is only a façade are falsely secure, superficially attached to their religion and they need to know that they’re headed for God’s wrath as much as the immoral.

Paul moves from condemnation to glorification and from positional truth to practical truth.

Jesus’ death and resurrection are the basis for the believer’s redemption, justification, reconciliation and glorification.

From the beginning of history there is conflict between works and grace.

Belief that salvation is based on faith alone in Christ alone does not mean Christians can do whatever they want, whenever they want and however they want to do it.

Our God is a good God and He will do the right thing because He alone is righteous.

And God’s ultimate goal is that we turn to Him and have relationship with Him.

The One judging is perfect and the condemnation is perfect.

He discovers that God’s attitude and his own attitude toward his accumulation of self-righteousness are as far apart as possible.

Since the self-righteous prefer to stand on their human good deeds, their deeds will be used to indict them at the last judgment.

It is God’s work that saves us, NEVER our works.

All of his deeds are remembered by God and recorded in the book of good deeds, to be mentioned at the last judgment; examined thoroughly and they will still add up to relative righteousness.

It is to the advantage of everyone to have their sins judged by the justice of God at the cross and to be positive at the point of

God consciousness and at Gospel hearing.

Every person in the human race, who rejects Jesus Christ and His work, stands on his own works.

If any member of the human race, regardless of geographical isolation or language barrier, desires relationship with God after reaching God consciousness, then God will provide the necessary information, the Gospel message, through which that person can believe in Christ for eternal life.

There is something much more valuable than possessions and that is to have honor or integrity. Salvation is not only glory but it’s something of value, honor, which is precious beyond description.

To avoid hardness of heart, man must submit to God’s authority thru His Word.

God worked it out for us; not with sentimental love but by His justice.
