

“God is faithful to His Word”

Romans 3:6-8

Human pride doesn't want the responsibility of its sin and would rather talk about what's wrong with God.

“Total depravity” means every aspect of our being is affected by the corruption of sin so that there is nothing we can do that merits the approval or blessing of God.

The “wrath of God” means experiencing God's judgment.

God will never forsake His people or renege on His promises but none of His promises or covenants ever guaranteed the Jews a place in Heaven.

God is faithful because He doesn't lie and because He doesn't lie, He's true to His Word.

No matter what happens in human history, God will be proven true in the end.

Yes, we're free and secure in Christ, but never as a license to sin; just the opposite, because it's truly understanding what Jesus Christ did for us that causes us to deny ungodliness.

The rationalization of those who are not adjusted to the justice of God states that the liar should not be condemned if he advances the justice of God.

The idea that Christ has been judged for sins, does not keep Paul from being out from under spiritual death.

The recipient of judgment does not glorify God, it's the justice of God that's glorified in condemning that which is sinful and evil.

Man doesn't advance the glory of God, only God can advance the glory of God!

Arrogant self-righteousness is always critical of grace-oriented biblical teaching, but all the slander and maligning in the world cannot destroy the ministry of anyone who communicates Bible truth.

Paul does not contend that the means justifies the end, nor the end justifies the means.

There is no place under grace for the intrusion of man's self-righteousness or Satan's policy of evil and the only reason they ever enter at all is because people are ignorant of the Word of God.

Whenever biblical teaching is maligned, count on it, the integrity of God will deal with the culprit.
