Sermon Title: Am I Getting Through to You?

Texts: Exodus 19–20 · Deuteronomy 6:4–5 · Matthew 13:9 · Revelation 3:20

### Primary Texts

- Exodus 19–20 — God speaks with thunder at Sinai.
- Deuteronomy 6:4–5 — “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.”
- Matthew 13:9 — “He who has ears, let him hear.”
- Revelation 3:20 — “Behold, I stand at the door and knock...”

### God Speaks Through Creation

- Psalm 19:1–4 — The heavens declare the glory of God.
- Psalm 8:3 — The work of Your fingers, the moon and stars.
- Romans 1:18–20 — God’s invisible qualities clearly seen in creation.
- Romans 8:19–23 — Creation groans, awaiting redemption.

### God Speaks Through the Wind and the Spirit

- John 3:8 — The wind blows wherever it pleases... so it is with everyone born of the Spirit.
- Acts 2:2–4 — The sound of a mighty rushing wind at Pentecost.

### God Speaks Through the Conscience

- Romans 2:14–15 — The law written on the heart.
- Titus 1:15 — To the pure all things are pure.
- Psalm 139:23 — Search me, O God, and know my heart.
- Colossians 3:15 — Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts.
- Romans 9:1 — My conscience confirms it through the Holy Spirit.
- Hebrews 9:14 — The blood of Christ cleanses our consciences.
- 1 Timothy 4:1–2 — Consciences seared as with a hot iron.
- 1 Timothy 1:5, 19 — Hold on to faith and a good conscience.
- 2 Timothy 1:3 — Serving God with a clear conscience.

## God Speaks Through the Prophets

- 2 Peter 1:21 — Prophets spoke from God, carried by the Holy Spirit.
- Hebrews 1:1 — God spoke through the prophets in many ways.
- Hosea 11:1 — Out of Egypt I called My Son.
- Hosea 11:8 — My heart is changed within Me; all My compassion is aroused.
- Malachi 3:6 — I the Lord do not change.
- Romans 15:4 — Everything written was to teach us and give hope.

## God Speaks Through His Word

- 2 Timothy 3:16 — All Scripture is God-breathed.
- Hebrews 4:12 — The Word of God is living and active, sharper than a sword.

## God Speaks Through His Spirit

- John 16:13 — The Spirit of truth will guide you into all truth.
- John 10:27 — My sheep hear My voice and follow Me.
- Psalm 95:7–8 — Today, if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts.
