

“Crisis in America” 2nd Corinthians 12:9-10

Right priorities are never developed in the crisis; they must be developed before the crisis and that means persistence and consistency in learning, understanding, believing and applying biblical truth.

Suffering poses no threat to the plan of God; the pain of adversity is real but even the most horrible suffering loses its dread in the light of the grace of God!
